

Covid-19 Guide



The health and wellbeing of the children, parents and our staff is of upmost importance. Here are the ten ways we'll be keeping everyone safe this summer:

1. Reduced Capacity

In order to adhere to social distancing guidelines, we will be offering a reduced number of spaces at our holiday club. We may run at multiple sites in order to increase our capacity and offer childcare to even more families.

2. Bubbles

Children will be placed in small bubbles in age groups. Those aged 8 and under will be in groups of 10 and over 8's in groups of 15. Plus, our staff will stay with the same group each day and the groups will not mix with others.

3. Restricted Spaces

To try and ensure bubbles do not interact with each other, they will be separated in different areas of the site, including having their own sections of the playground/field and use of specific toilets.

4. Separate Equipment

Where possible, bubbles will not share equipment and where a piece of equipment must be used by each bubble, such as cooking utensils, it will be disinfected thoroughly between uses.

5. Condensed Hours

Again, to try and ensure bubbles do not interact with each other we will not be offering our usual breakfast and late pick up services, or half day options. The day will run from 08:30 to 17:00.

6. Staggered Drop Off/Collection

To maintain social distancing, we will be staggering drop off and collection times for each bubble. Times will be confirmed shortly before the club opens for Summer and will be as close to 08:30 and 17:00 as possible.

7. Contactless Sign In/Out

Registration will be managed at the entrance to site and your child/ren will be signed in and out by the group leader. Please note, we will be operating a cash free environment and will only be accepting credit and debit card payments.

8. Thorough Hygiene Practices

Children and staff will be asked to wash their hands thoroughly on arrival, between each activity and departure. Hand sanitizer will be readily available. Face masks and gloves will be available for staff and will always be used when administering first aid.

9. Managing Covid-19 Symptoms

Anyone displaying Coronavirus symptoms will not be allowed on-site until they have met the isolation or testing requirements. Should anyone start to show symptoms whilst at Clubland, we have robust isolation protocols which will be implemented.

10. Enhanced Cleaning Routines

Touch hotspots will be regularly cleaned with disinfectant wipes throughout the day. Equipment will also be cleaned/disinfected at the end of each activity. Surfaces will be cleaned before and after use and enhanced cleaning regimes will take place every evening.
